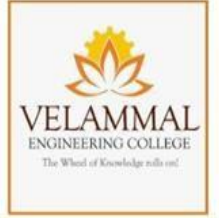

“ARAM EVENT”

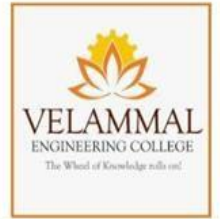
The Aram event was conducted by the NSS UNIT of Velammal Engineering College.

Objectives:

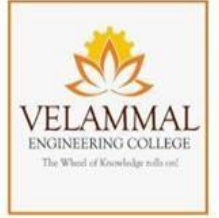
- To foster meaningful interactions with the children at the orphanage.

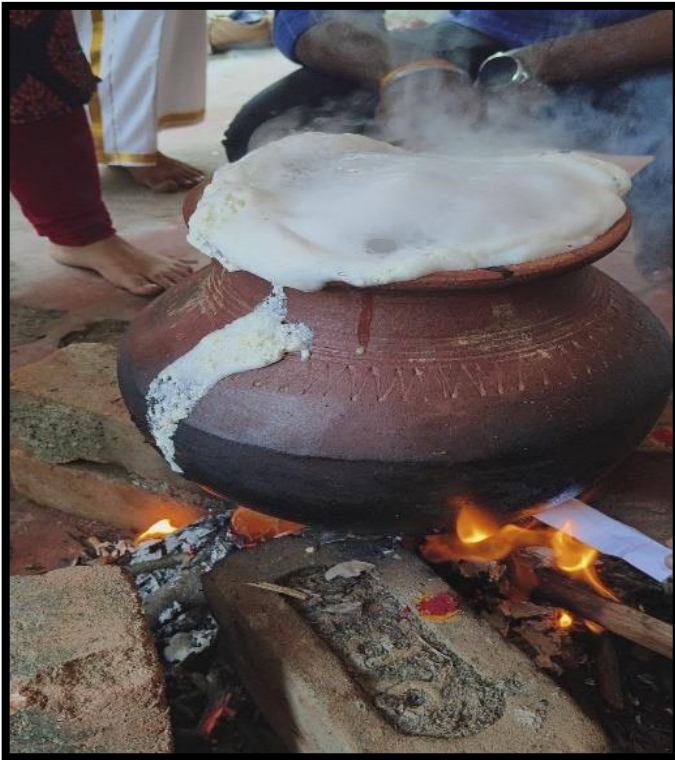
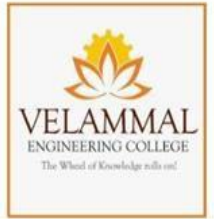
- The event "ARAM" was conducted by the NSS unit of Velammal Engineering College.

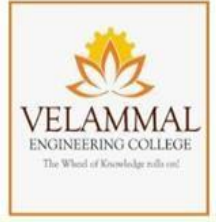
